







2015 ATD Compensation & Benefits Report Educational Attainment in Talent Development


What is the highest level of education you have attained?



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Well-Educated Instructional Designers Say Degrees Add Career Value



SHARED	Pros	Cons
University Degree <u>or</u> Industry Credential	Often recognized globally; networking opportunities/ job leads; in-person and online access/format; often professional dev. \$ available; taught by professionals in the field; can compensate for "hiccups" on resume	*depending on filing status, some programs can be tax-deductible

	Pros	Cons
University Degree	Formal education; valid for life	Cost; duration of program

	Pros	Cons
Industry Credential	More focused in chosen field; can often earn within a short period of time	Must recertify every few years; cross-industry awareness
